## REPORT OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE

STATE OF NEVADA, DEPARTMENT OF STATE,  
CARSON CITY, December 31, 1918.

*To His Excellency, EMMET D. BOYLE, Governor of Nevada.*

SIR: I have the honor to transmit herewith my fourth biennial report, covering the years 1917 and 1918, for the office of Secretary of State.

The business of the office is shown in detail in the several tables, with the exception of land patents, of which 585 were placed on record during this biennial period. Lists of motor-vehicle owners were published in pamphlet form, early in each year, and copies furnished to various officials to facilitate the enforcement of the provisions of the motor-vehicle law and the collection of licenses, and I congratulate these officials upon the thoroughness of their work in this respect.

The receipts of the office total \$124,132.07. This is very gratifying, as it continues to show a substantial increase over late preceding years.

The office is in excellent working order and with the system employed the vast amount of business transacted in the office is handled with the greatest possible dispatch.

I wish to thank you and the other state officers for many courtesies received.

Senators are elected for four years and Assemblymen for two years. Sessions are biennial, convening third Monday of January of odd-numbered years—January 20, 1919. Duration of session, 60 days. Salary, \$10 per day, not to exceed \$800, and 15 cents per mile for each mile actually traveled in going to and returning from the place of meeting, which said mileage shall, however, be computed, in all cases, upon the shortest practical routes to the said place of meeting. Also \$20 for newspapers and stationery.
