By the Public Health Act, 1875, the Sanitary Acts were intended to be consolidated, so as to render them more intelligible and easier for reference to the practitioner and officials carrying the Acts into operation; but the length of the present Act renders it difficult for any person to take a clear view of its provisions on certain subjects without the risk of overlooking some clause bearing on the question. The Act is certainly divided into parts, but there are sections in many parts which have reference entirely to sections in other parts.

To prevent the inconvenience and wast of time which must necessarily arise in searching out the several sections affecting any subject, the compiler has arranged the whole of the Public Health Act, 1875, into an Alphabetical Index, and, under each heading, has introduced the several sections referring thereto; and where the sections refer to more than one subject, a reference has been carried forward to the several headings.
