

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PREFACE.

The present parallel text edition of King Henry V. is based on a transcript of the First and Third Quartos (Q: und Q.) and the 1623 Folio (F1).

The transcript was made from Mr. Praetorius' Facsimile of Qu and Qe and from Professor Bang's copy of Dr. Sidney Lee's Facsimile of the Chatsworth Folio (Oxford, Clarendon Press, 1902). The British Museum copies of the Quartos [Q:: (C. 12, g. 22); Q: (C. 34. k. 14)] have been collated throughout, and the printed text revised by Miss L. Krebs with the Hodleian copies (Q1, Q: Malone 32; F: Malone 1. Arch. F.).

Dr. Nicholson's Reprint in Series II of the New Shakspere Society's Publications (Lo. 1877) has been very useful in checking the texts but contains a certain number of uncorrected misprints (at instead of ft etc.).
