CHAPTER I.

INTRODUCTORY.

THERE is probably no complaint more prevalent in England, and especially in London, than Winter Cough. It derives its importance not from its fatality but from the fact that it returns year after year with unvarying regularity, rendering the life of the unfortunate sufferer miserable and incapacitating him from following his avocations. We recognise it clinically, being only too familiar with its salient features, although, curiously enough, it corresponds to no definite pathological condition. It may be said to be of a somewhat composite character, including as it does bronchial catarrh, chronic bronchitis with or without emphysema, bronchiectasis, and a small percentage of cases of quiescent or arrested phthisis.
