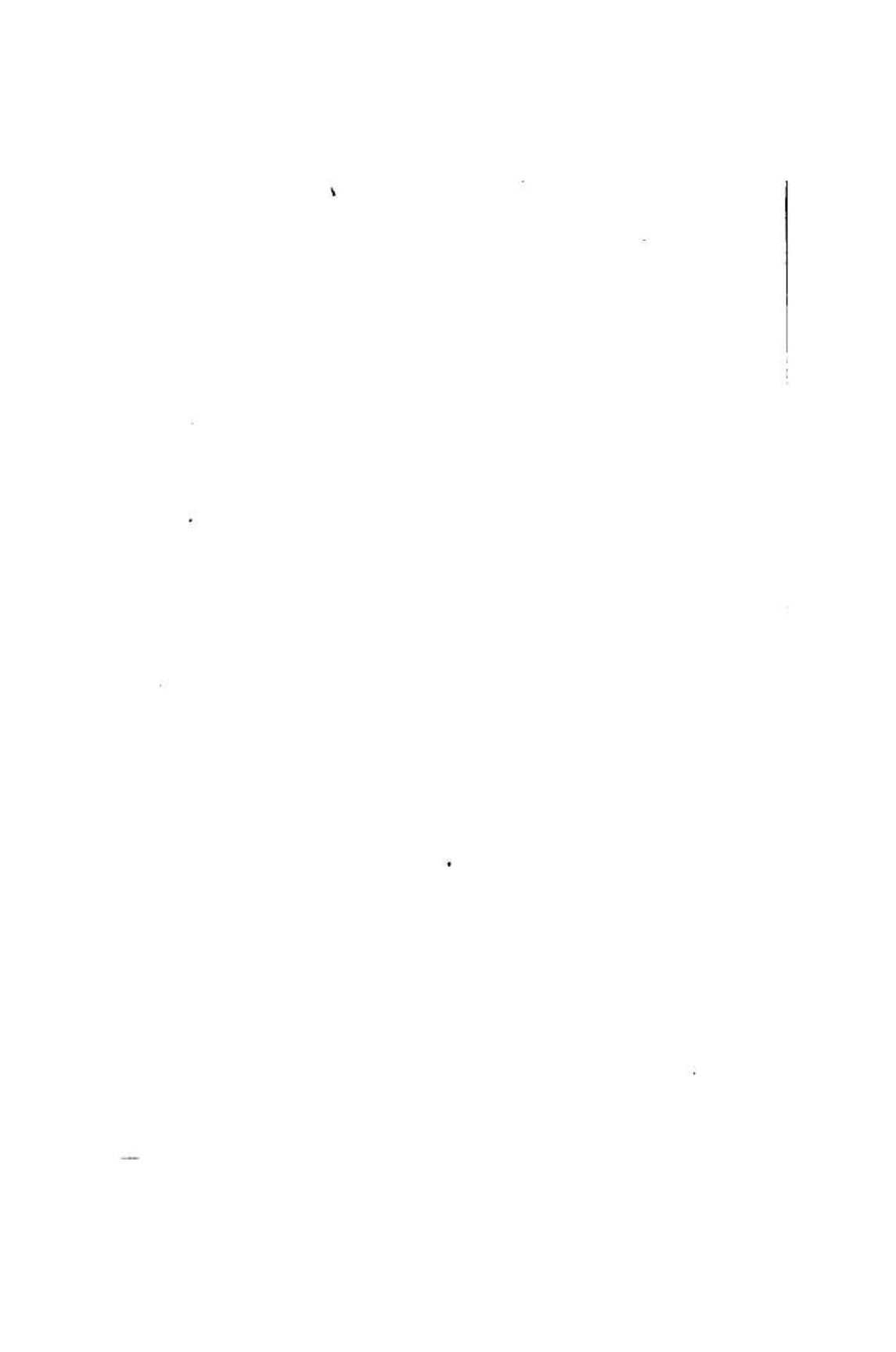

BISHOP OF CHESTER¹.

AN Inventorie taken of all the goodes and cattalles of the late reverend father in God Hugh Bushoppe of Chester by John Ratcliffe &c. the xxiiijth day of June 1596 In the groomes chamber Imp^mis a fetherbed bolster and a mattresse with a matte xl^a — a Welsh double couerlet and ij blankettes xvj^s — a porte mantow and a male v^a — a presse iiij^s — a boards in the windowe xviiij^d — a bedsteed iiij^s — a crosse stools of sylinge wth a panne iiij^s In my L. chamber a matte and a mattresse a fetherbedd a bolster and two pillowes iiijth vj^s viij^d — a paire of greene sey curtaines and vallances xxvj^s viij^d — a bedsteede xxvj^s viij^d — ij white blankette with a caddowe and a coveringe blacke and greene xx^a — two trunkes xv^a — six bedde staves j^d — a caaket ij^s — a chaire and a cushion ij^s vj^d — a presse

¹ Hugh Bellot, D.D., son of Thomas Bellot of Moreton co. Cost. Eq., of St. John's College, Cambridge, Rector of Tydde in Cambridgeshire, Vicar of Gresford in Denbighshire, consecrated Bishop of Bangor 26th January 1586, translated to Chester 25th June 1596, and dying in 1596 aged 64 was buried at Wrexham, where a monument was erected to his memory by his brother Cuthbert Bellot, B.D., Archdeacon of Chester. — Ormerod, vol. i. pp. 76, 89.
