¹ Hugh Bellot, D.D., son of Thomas Bellot of Moreton co. Cest. Esq., of St. John's College, Cambridge, Rector of Tydde in Cambridgeshire, Vicar of Gresford in Denbighshire, consecrated Bishop of Bangor 26th January 1585, translated to Chester 26th June 1596, and dying in 1596 sged 54 was buried at Wrenham, where a monument was erected to his memory by his brother Cuthbert Bellot, B.D., Archdesson of Chester. — Ormerod, vol. i. pp. 75, 89.
