Our health had not, indeed, suffered to any great extent; but we felt ourselves weaker than we had been, and we thought it would be necessary, for a time, to change our rude manner of living. In this point of view, a country inhabited by the Chinese could hardly fail to appear desirable, for, compared with Tartary, it offered us every comfort.
