ORIGIN OF THE HAIL MARY

Next to the Our Father, which our Lord Jesus Christ Himself taught us, the Hail Mary is the best, the most beautiful and efficacious of prayers. It has also a divine origin, for each of its three parts has been taught by God Himself. The first part, "Hail (Mary), full of grace, the Lord is with thee, blessed art thou among women," was the greeting which the angel Gabriel, God's special messenger to the virgin Mary, addressed to her (Luke 1, 27, 28). The second part, "Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb (Jesus)" (v. 41, 42), was the reply St. Elizabeth, "filled with the Holy Ghost," made to Mary's greeting. And the Catholic Church, "the Church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth" (1 Tim. 3.15), founded by Jesus Christ and guided by the Holy Ghost, "the Spirit of truth" (John 15. 26), has added the third part, "Holy
