PREFACE

The following monograph was first prepared under the guidance and inspiration of the late Professor Charles Gross and was accepted in partial fulfilment of the requirements for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in Harvard University in 1908. It was also awarded the Toppan Prize in the same year.
