These tales are free from the coarseness which disfigures the "Confessions of a Fool," and the morbid gloom which broods over the "Inferno." The second tale is especially interesting as recording Strindberg's impressions of London, which he visited only once (in 1853) and did not like.

He led a vagabond life for many years, working and tramping with the poorest classes in Russia, and his writings record the tragedy of poverty and crime as he found it. Among the best known of his works are 'MAKAR CHUDRA' (1890), 'EMILIAN PIBGAI,' 'CHELKASH,' 'OSHYBKA' (1895), 'TYENOVYA KARTINKI' (1895), 'TOSKA,' 'KONOVALOV' (1896), 'MALVA' (1896), 'FOMA GORDYEV' (1901), 'MUJIKI' (1901). Three volumes of short stories (1898-99), 'MIESTCHANYE' (1902), 'COMRADES' (1907), 'THE SPY' (1908), and 'IN THE DEPTHS,' a play."—*Century Cyclopædia of Names.*
