INTRODUCTION.

This list is merely an abridgement of the serial entries in the accession book of the museum. The preparation of a classified catalogue would require more time than is now available, but as lists of both kinds are required for ready reference, one of the latter will probably be prepared to accompany this.

When specimens are referred to as belonging to a "collection," it means that the contributor has presented fifty or more pieces.

When specimens have been purchased from reputable local collectors, the names of only the original finders are here given.

Owners of property on which specimens have been found in the course of the Curator's field-work, are credited as donors.

The most generous friend of the museum is Dr. T. W. Beeman, of Perth, through whom, directly and indirectly, many hundreds of valuable specimens have come into our possession, as a result of which primitive life in the country about Lake Rideau is very fully illustrated, perhaps more so than any other district in the Province.
