SYRACUSE, N. Y., May 16th, 1861.

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE PRESEYTERIAN CHURCH IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA MET, agreeably to appointment, in the First Presbyterian Church of the city of STRACUSE, N. Y., on Thursday, the 16th of May, 1861, at 11 o'clock A.M., and was opened with a sermon, by the Rev. THORNTON A. MILLS, the Moderator of the last Assembly, from 1 Tim. 3: 14, 15: "These things write I unto thee, hoping to come unto thee shortly ; but, if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth."

After the sermon, the Assembly was constituted with prayer. Adjourned until 3 o'clock P.M. Concluded with prayer.
