SIXTEENTH, or the Queen's Regiment of (Light) Dra-  
goons, 1776-1778.

Seventeenth Regiment of (Light) Dragoons, 1776-1782.

Third (the Buffs) Regiment, 1781-1782.

Fourth (or the King's Own) Regiment of Foot, 1775-1780.

In 1781 the regiment was sent to Ireland.

Fifth Regiment of Foot, 1775-1780.

1775-1780. Hugh, Earl Percy.

In 1774 this regiment was in Ireland, and it returned  
to that island in 1781.

Sixth Regiment of Foot, 1775-1778.

1775-1778. Sir William Boothby, *Bt.*

It was brought from the Charibbee Islands in 1774.

Seventh (or Royal Fusileers) Regiment of Foot, 1774-1776;

Eighth Regiment of Foot, 1774-1782.

In 1783 it was transferred to Canada, and became
