BROOKLYN, NEW-YORK, May 18th, 1865.

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA met, agreeably to appointment, in the La Fayette Avenue Presbyterian Church, of the city of BROOKLYN, NEW-YORK, on Thursday, the 18th of May, 1865, at 11 o'clock A.M., and was opened with a sermon, by the Rev. Thomas Brainerd, D.D., the Moderator of the last Assembly, from Proverbs 11: 30: "He that winneth souls is wise."

After the sermon, the Assembly was constituted with prayer.

The Committee of Arrangements reported, recommending that the sessions of the Assembly be opened at 8½ o'clock A.M., and 3 o'clock P.M.; that they close at 12½ and 5½ o'clock P.M.; that the evening services commence at 7½ o'clock; and that the first hour of the morning session be appropriated to devotional exercises. The report was adopted,

Adjourned until 34 c'clock P.M. Concluded with prayer.

THURSDAY, May 18th, 84 o'clock P.M.

The Assembly met, and was opened with prayer.
