To the Legislature of the State of Michigan:

In compliance with the law, I have the honor herewith to present the annual report of the business of this Department for the fiscal year ending June 30th, 1920, including official opinions and an abstract of the official reports of the Prosecuting Attorneys of the counties of the State, showing the number of prosecutions, convictions, acquittals, etc.
