## PREFATORY NOTE

I have written this book with the prayer that it may be read by many to whom the Gospel narratives are as sealed books. The Bible is a volume which everybody respects, which few people read, and which fewer study. I cherish the hope that some into whose hands this little book falls may be inspired by it to examine the Sacred Story to see whether these things be true or not.

I have followed closely the order of events so far as I could determine them, only deviating from the record in one instance—the futile attempt of Judas to exculpate himself. This took place after the second trial of Jesus by the Sanhedrin in the morning, and the money was cast down in the Temple, instead of in the High Priest's house as I have arranged it. I did not deem it necessary to repeat the second trial which was practically identical with the first, hence the change noted.
