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EXPLANATORY REMARKS.

In our translation we adopted these principles:

- 1. Tenan of the original—We have learned in a Mishna; Tanio—We have learned in a Boraitha; Itemar—It was taught.
- Questions are indicated by the interrogation point, and are immediately followed by the answers, without being so marked.
- When in the original there occur two statements separated by the phrase, Lishna achieva or Walhayith Aema (literally, "otherwise interpreted"), we translate only the second.
- 4. As the pages of the original are indicated in our new Hebrew edition, it is not deemed necessary to mark them in the English edition, this being only a translation from the latter.

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
