In 1895 the Hatch experiment station and the Massachusetts agricultural experiment station were consolidated under the title: Hatch experiment station of the Massachusetts agricultural college. The reports of the Massachusetts agricultural experiment station had appeared in the Documents since 1883 appended to the report of the Board of agriculture, and since 1889 independently.

Published since 1853. Include Annual reports of the Hatch experiment station since 1895; of the Dairy bureau since 1891; of the Cattle commissioners since 1884; reports on extermination of gypsy moth since 1891; reports of delegates to the Farmers' national congress since 1891; financial returns of societies since 1858; Directory of Massachusetts agricultural organizations since 1889. Contain also reports of lectures and discussions at public meetings of the board, and many other essays and papers of interest and value.

Massachusetts— *Board of Charity.*

Annual reports.

Mass. Public Documents since 1864. (No. 17 since 1866.)

The Board of state charities [including lunacy] was established in 1863; consolidated with the State board of health in 1879, and called State board of health, lunacy and charity till 1886, when the two boards were separated. In 1898 a separate Board of insanity was created, and the Board of lunacy and charity became the Board of Charity. The report for 1885 contains a general index to supplements 1-7.

Previous to 1866 the returns were published by the Secretary of the Commonwealth. From 1866 to 1875 were published the 1st to 10th reports of the Commissioner of savings banks; in 1876 the series of reports of the Board of commissioners began. Since 1881 the reports have contained the statutes relating to savings banks.

Massachusetts— Board of *Harbor and land commissioners*.

Mass. Public Documents since 1879. (No. 11.)

Commissioners on Boston harbor and the Back Bay established in 1853; called Commissioners on the Back Bay, 1855-60; Board of commissioners on public lands, 1861-76; Board of land commissioners, 1877-78; in the Public Documents since 1857. Consolidated in 1879 with Board of harbor commissioners which had been established in 1867, and had had its reports in the Public Documents since 1877.
