NOTE TO THE ALUMNI.

The delay in the publication of the *Register* has been due to the difficulty of securing the necessary information. The book was planned two years ago, but it is only recently that sufficient material has been collected to make anything like completeness possible. As it is, the *Register* is fairly complete, and as free from errors as we have been able to make it.

For convenience of reference, the purely alphabetical arrangement of the names has been modified by an arrangement according to the year of graduation. Thus, all names beginning with A are printed in a body, but so arranged that those belonging to the same year are grouped together. These groups begin with 1892 and follow one another in chronological order. Addresses which are starred (*) indicate that no report has been received from the person in question, but that the information given concerning him is believed by the editors to be correct.

For the sake of completeness, the names of the graduating class of the present year have been inserted. It should be understood, however, that the *Register* is printed before these degrees are conferred, so that the Class of '99 appears simply in the character of prospective Alumni.

The editors wish to urge upon the Alumni the importance of reporting changes of address and other matters of interest. This information is necessary for communication and for any subsequent edition of the *Register*. Finally, the editors, for themselves and on behalf of the Executive Committee, express the hope that the *Register*, even in its present form, will be found useful in many respects, and that it will be a new tie to bind the Alumni together, and to bring them into closer relationship with our beloved *Alma Mater*.
