LESSON I.—ADAM. *Page 1.*

Adam a type of our Lord as being first man. Our Lord the firstborn among many brethren in the world of grace. Adam the father of all men. Our Lord the Father of all who believe in Him. Adam's marriage with Eve typical of our Lord's union with the Church. Adam first Lord, or King. Our Lord shall reign over all the earth. Adam covenant head or representative of all men. Our Lord head or representative of his people. Adam brought sin and death into the world. Our Lord, pardon and life. Adam was tempted in Paradise, and fell. Our Lord was tempted in the wilderness, and conquered. Adam lost access to the tree of life. Our Lord restores it. Subjects for texts on the history of Adam.

LESSON II.—NOAH. *Page 16.*

Noah, a type of our Lord as a preacher. Very few believed Noah's message. Very few believed in our Lord. Noah head, or builder of the ark. Our Lord head of his Church. Noah a type of our Lord in offering up sacrifice. Our Lord offered up Himself. All in the ark were saved from death. All in Christ are saved from eternal death. The dove, the rainbow, the one door, one window, all typical

of our Lord. The name Noah, signifies rest, or comfort. Christ the rest of the believer. Subjects for texts on the history of Noah.

LESSON III.—MELCHIZEDEK. *Page 28.*

Melchizedek a type of our Lord, as being king of righteousness and king of peace. Our Lord puts his righteousness upon all who believe, and gives them peace in believing. Melchizedek brought forth bread and wine for the refreshment of Abraham and his followers. The Lord Jesus strengthens his people, who feed upon his body and blood by faith. Melchizedek priest of the Most High God. Our Lord the one great High Priest. Melchizedek blessed Abram. Our Lord sent to bless his people by turning them away from their iniquities. Melchizedek said to be without father or mother, having neither beginning of days nor end of life. Our Lord without mother as God, without father as man: from everlasting to everlasting. Melchizedek a type of our Lord, as being king and priest. Our Lord was both king and priest, as well as prophet. Subjects for texts on the history of Melchizedek.

LESSON IV.—ISAAC. *Page 39.*

Isaac a child of promise, as was our Lord. Isaac a type of our Lord in willingly offering up himself. Abraham's willingness to give up Isaac to death, a shadow of the love of God, who gave up his well-beloved Son. Abraham for three days considered Isaac dead. Our Lord lay dead three days in the grave. Isaac offered up on Mount Moriah. Our Lord supposed to be offered up on the same mountain. Isaac carried the wood for the burnt-offering. Our Lord carried His cross. It was by his father that Isaac was to be put to death. It was by God the Father's will that our Lord suffered. After

looking upon Isaac as dead for three days, Abraham received him again as from the dead. So, after lying three days in the grave, our Lord arose;—Isaac returned to his home, and became the father of many nations, so, our Lord ascended up to heaven, and became the Father of those who are begotten again to a lively hope by His resurrection from the dead. Isaac's perfect obedience to his father, typical of our Lord's, who came not to do His own will, but the will of Him who sent Him. Subjects for texts on the history of Isaac.

LESSON V.—JACOB. *Page 51.*

Jacob chosen by God to be the Father of the Jewish nation before he was born. The Lord Jesus Christ chosen before the foundation of the world to be the Father of all that believe. From Jacob the Jewish people are named Israelites. From the Lord Jesus Christ His people are named Christians. The twelve patriarchs sprang from Jacob; the twelve apostles from the Lord Jesus Christ. The afflictions Jacob suffered typical of those the Lord Jesus Christ endured. Jacob left his father's house, and crossed the river Jordan with his staff; after a time returned with great riches and two bands. The Lord Jesus left His home in heaven, passed through the Jordan of death, with his cross, and ascended up to heaven enriched with the purchase of his Church, leaving behind two bands, Jews and Gentiles. Jacob was obliged to go to Egypt to preserve his life, and the Lord Jesus Christ was obliged as a child to fly there to escape death by Herod. Jacob got his father's blessing in Esau's clothes; so believers are accepted through the righteousness of Christ. Esau selling his birthright for a mess of pottage, typical of those who forfeit heaven from setting their hearts on the world, and the things of the world. Subjects for texts on the history of Jacob.

LESSON VI.—JOSEPH. *Page 66.*

Joseph, a type of our Lord as a well-beloved Son—a servant—an innocent sufferer—a prophet. Like our Lord, Joseph was persecuted by his brethren, though an affectionate brother; as was our Lord. Joseph was a type of our Lord also, in being able to resist temptations, to forgive injuries; an exalted prince, and a Saviour of the Egyptian people. Joseph was sold for a servant; our Lord was sold by Judas. Joseph, after much trial and suffering, exalted to the highest post in the kingdom, and the means of saving many thousand lives. Our Lord, after the death of the Cross, exalted to heaven, and the Saviour of all who believe in Him. Subjects for texts on the history of Joseph.

LESSON VII.—MOSES. *Page 79.*

Moses, a type of our Lord as a deliverer, a lawgiver, and a prophet. As Moses, by the blood of the Paschal Lamb delivered the people from Egyptian bondage, so the Lord Jesus, by shedding His blood, saves His people from the power of sin and Satan. Moses gave the law; our Lord kept it. Moses was a prophet and a mediator; in both respects a type of our Lord. Moses in the meekness of his temper, a type of our Lord. Also in the lustre of his face. As Moses was obliged to veil his face after he had communion with God, when he conversed with the Israelites, so our Lord veiled His Godhead, and took upon Him our flesh, when He came to dwell on our earth. Moses likewise a type of our Lord in the miracles that he wrought. Subjects for texts on the history of Moses.

LESSON VIII.—JOSHUA. *Page 97.*

Joshua, which signifies Jesus, or Saviour, a type of our Lord, in being called to lead the Israelites into the pro-

mised land. Our Lord brings His people safely to heaven. Joshua brought the Israelites through the river Jordan. Our Lord carries His people through the Jordan of death. Twelve stones set up for a memorial of the passage through Jordan. Our Lord appointed twelve apostles to be witnesses of His miracles. Joshua overthrew the city of Jericho with the aid of priests and trumpets. Typical of our Lord overthrowing the strongholds of sin and Satan through the preaching of the Gospel. Joshua saved the harlot Rahab. Typical of our Lord saving Gentiles as well as Jews. The scarlet line hung out by Rahab, a type of the blood of Christ, which is the security of the believer. Joshua victorious over the Canaanitish kings; typical of our Lord getting complete victory over all His enemies. Subjects for texts on the history of Joshua.

LESSON IX.—DAVID. *Page 114.*

David, which signifies, Beloved, born at Bethlehem, the birth-place of our Lord. David, a type of our Lord as shepherd and king. David persecuted by Saul; our Lord by Herod. Many priests suffered death on account of David; many innocent children on account of Christ. Both David and his Lord escaped. David forsaken and betrayed by an intimate friend; our Lord by Judas. David's victory over Goliath, typical of our Lord's victory over Satan. David conquering the stronghold of Zion, typical of our Lord purchasing the Gentile Church. The name David frequently applied to Christ. Subjects for texts on the history of David.

LESSON X.—SOLOMON. *Page 132.*

Solomon, a type of our Lord in respect of his great wisdom and knowledge. Also, in his immense wealth. The riches of Christ unsearchable. Solomon, a type of our

Lord in his large dominion, and in the multitude of people over whom he reigned. Solomon's reign one of great peace and prosperity. Typical of the thousand years when our Lord shall reign over all the earth. Solomon's marriage with a foreigner, typical of our Lord's calling the Gentile Church. The temple that Solomon built, a type of the Church or body of Christ. All the stones for the temple cut and prepared, away from Jerusalem. The children of God made meet for heaven while on earth. Subjects for texts on the history of Solomon.

LESSON XI.—JONAH. *Page 151.*

Jonah, a type of our Lord, as being the first preacher sent to the Gentiles, and as preaching the doctrine of repentance. Jonah offered himself up to save others; our Lord offered Himself up for the sins of His people. Jonah, three days and three nights in the whale's belly; our Lord three days and three nights in the grave. Jonah, being restored after three days to light, life, and liberty, typical of our Lord being raised from the dead the third day. Jonah preaching to the Ninevites; typical of our Lord, after His resurrection, preaching to the Gentiles by His twelve apostles. Jonah angry because the Ninevites repented and were saved. Our Lord wept over the sinners in Jerusalem because they would not repent, and so perished. Subjects for texts on the history of Jonah.
