### INTRODUCTORY.

MY DEAR TEACHER: I am afraid you thought me very irreverent in what I said in the class last Sabbath about the Old Testament and the sacrifices of the Bible. I did not mean to be irreverent. I was brought up to reverence the Bible and to believe everything that is in it, but I have heard so much lately-sometimes, too, from Christians, and even from ministers—that is contrary to what I was taught as a child that I hardly know what to believe. When I was in Blast summer, I heard Dr. — preach; he is a lovely preacher, and everybody went to hear him. He preached about Christ, and said "the blood of Christ was not an essential thing in Christ's work: it was his life and the way that life influenced ours." He said, too, we had "nothing to do with the sacrifices of
