

REPORT.

To the Honorable General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island:

The State Board of Education respectfully submits this its Eleventh Annual Report.

In addition to the four required by law, two special meetings have been held during the year. Of the various matters of routine, as also of the special subjects that have claimed and received attention, the most are such as call for no particular notice here. Many topics moreover upon which this Board would, under other circumstances, feel called upon and desirous to offer considerations and suggestions to your Honorable Body from year to year, are so fully and so well treated by the State Commissioner, in his successive annual reports, and commonly quite in the spirit and in the line which the Board itself would be disposed to adopt, that further discussion of them would be likely to involve needless repetition and reiteration.

One important function of this Board is the oversight and general direction of the State Normal School. Upon this branch of its work a special report is as usual herewith submitted.
