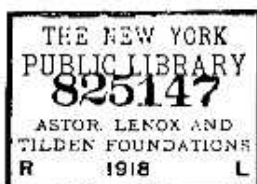

P R E F A C E.

THE pages following contain the substance of three addresses delivered in London, and have since appeared in a series of articles in an American publication. There have been so many evidences that the blessed truth sought to be set forth in these pages has been helpful to those who have heard the talks, or read them in article form, that the author has been induced to put them together in a little booklet.

The tendency, evermore showing itself in the human heart, toward legalism, even among God's own people, is so strong, that, unless we are careful to differentiate very carefully the Law from the Gospel, we are in constant danger of falling into darkness and despondency, on account of our manifest spiritual imperfections and shortcomings.

There is no lesson more difficult for the Christian to learn than that of "salvation by grace." We, through grace, "begin in the Spirit," and then unless we are careful to know the mind and heart of God toward us, we seek to "make perfect by the flesh." Nothing but "grace—free, unbounded grace"—will suffice for our need. That grace of God hath now appeared, bringing salvation to all men, being poured out upon us abundantly by Jesus Christ (Titus ii. 11-14). It is our unspeakable privilege to live in it and to walk in "and know the love of God, which passeth knowledge." We cannot be presumptuous in sitting, standing, walking, working, and living in the "South Window of His Love."

If the dear Master shall bless the reading of these humble pages as He has been pleased to bless the same message when delivered orally, the author will be profoundly grateful, and a thousand times repaid for the slight labour involved in preparing them.
