

Introductory Note.

EMILE VERHAEREN, one of the most remarkable of the brilliant group of writers representing "Young Belgium," and one who has been recognized by the literary world of France as holding a foremost place among the lyric poets of the day, was born at St. Amand, near Antwerp, in 1855. His childbood was passed on the banks of the Scheldt, in the midst of the wide-spreading Flemish plains, a country of mist and flood, of dykes and marshes, and the impressions he received from the mysterious, melancholy character of these surroundings, bave produced a marked and lasting influence upon his work.
