



Explanatory Note

I AVE you anything in print on the subject of prophecy and the Lord's return?" This question has been asked the author many times, especially during the progress of this awful war. And when he has answered, "Yes," it has been necessary to name different books, periodicals or newspapers, to which he has contributed chapters or articles on the subject, most of which were not easily obtainable. Therefore to accommodate such inquirers, and to bring what he has written into a connected whole, he has gathered the different contributions together in this volume.

There has been some repetition in the various chapters necessarily, because of the different circumstances under which they were written, but care has been taken to reduce it to a minimum. A difference in style also will be noticed, which is explained by the fact that some of the chapters were written for the publications in which they were found, while others were addresses spoken offhand and stenographically reported.

In order to round out the treatment of the subject, it has been thought desirable to use, with a few changes, three chapters taken from the author's own books, "Satan and the Saint," "Great Epochs of Sacred History," and "Salvation from Start to Finish." For the other chapters acknowledgment is due to *The Christian Herald*, Winona Echoes, "Our God Shall Come" (Waters), and "Addresses on Prophecy" (Watchword and Truth).
