It has seemed to me desirable to preserve in permanent form such genealogical notes as I have, lest they be lost or mislaid, and I am making them as complete as possible.


Besides the direct lines of the families of my father and mother and your mother's father and mother, there are others that are interesting, which are added in an appendix.


