OCTAVIUS BROOKS FROTHINGHAM

THE Reception given at the Union League Theatre, April 22d, 1879, in honor of the Rev. O. B. FROTHINGHAM, was of such peculiar interest to those who hold the Liberal Faith dear that it has been thought well to preserve some record of it in printed form.

Mr. FROTHINGHAM had, early in the year, announced his desire to seek rest, by travel abroad, from the severe intellectual strain of an unbroken service of twenty years, and had tendered his resignation of the pastorate of the Independent Liberal Church, to take effect from the 1st of May. The Trustees of the church, being unwilling to lose him altogether, had persuaded him to withdraw his resignation and to take a vacation of a year or more. Knowing the carnest desire of the members of his congregation to meet him once more socially, and, in giving him a farewell greeting, to express in some measure their appreciation of his work for them and for the community, they resolved to invite the members of the Society, together with a few friends of Mr. FROTHINGHAM and of the cause, to meet him for that purpose, and appointed from their own number as a committee to make the necessary arrangements, J. H. Morse, Geo. Haven Putnam, and Frank Fuller.

It soon became apparent to the committee that Mr.
