The present edition comprises *The Voyage of Arundel* and other Poems published by the late Mr. Camden Hotten in 1871 under the title of 'Rhymes from Cornwall.' To these are now added 'The Knell of Saint Germans' Tower, which was published as 'A Lament for Eliot' with other ballads relating to the Crimean War in 1855; 'The Plaint of Morwenstow,' published separately after the death of the Rev. R. S. Hawker; and the Elegy of 'Lanhydrock,' of which an edition with a biographical note appeared in 1882. A few smaller compositions are interspersed, either not before printed, or taken from booklets of verse now out of print. The frontispiece is from a sketch of the rock called *The Armed Knight*, near the *Land's End*, made for this edition by Mr. R. H. Carter of Falmouth, who has so frequently and faithfully depicted the coast scenery of Cornwall.
