Thomas Greson, or Greson, was not only like his townsman and contemporary, Turner, famous for his knowledge in divinity, physic, and botany, but was one of the early English printers. Bale mentions him in terms of high commendation, and says, his cures were almost incredible. He entered zealously into the spirit of the Reformation, and wrote in its favour; but, during the Marian persecution, fled to the continent, from whence he returned on the accession of Elizabeth, and settled in London, where he died in 1562. All his works were printed by himself, excepting the last in the list given of them in the note* below: but it does not
