PREFACE.

THE following Prayers were manifestly written and intended for the Christian's private and individual use. In the hope that they may be once again so employed, I am induced to edite a reprint in this Manual Form. For, even in times in which there is a tendency to revive too many obsolete Forms, no candid Christian can object—on the ground of its antiquity, only—to the republication of that which, in itself is unequivocally good, and in its effects may be, by God's Blessing, eminently useful.

I am sorry that it is not in my power to give any information, as to their authorship. They first attracted my attention, in an Edition of the Prayer Book, published in 1636; subsequently, in Editions of 1620 and 1618.

Having consulted Wheatly and Mant, as well as Comber, in reference to them, and obtained no satisfactory result, I was induced to apply to Dr.
