## Rules.

### I.

#### OBJECTS OF THE SOCIETY.

To study and preserve the antiquities of the East Riding of the County of York, and to popularise the archæology of the district.

### II.

#### NAME.

The name of the Society shall be "The East Riding Antiquarian Society (Yorkshire)."

### III.

#### OPERATION.

1. Meetings shall be held for the reading of papers, the exhibition of antiquities, and discussion. The number of such meetings and their locality shall be at the discretion of the Council, but not less than four shall be held in each winter session.

2. Meetings shall be held at least once in every year at places rendered interesting by their antiquities.

3. A yearly volume shall be printed for the subscribers (not in arrears with their subscriptions), to be entitled the "Transactions" of the Society, containing original papers, reports, copies of ancient documents, etc. It shall be issued at the General Annual Meeting. The selection of *in extenso* papers, and the arrangement of the volume, shall be in the hands of a small Editorial Committee annually appointed by the Council.

### IV.

#### ADMISSION OF MEMBERS.

Candidates shall be proposed and seconded in writing by two members, and the election may take place at any meeting.

### V.

#### SUBSCRIPTION.

The Annual Subscription shall be ten shillings and sixpence, payable in advance on the first day of January in each year. The subscriptions of newly-elected members shall be payable immediately upon election. If any member shall allow his subscription to be in arrears for two years, and shall for the space of fourteen days from the giving of the notice hereinafter mentioned, fail to pay all arrears due from him, the Council, after having given such member, through the Secretary, fourteen days' notice of their intention to do so, may declare him to be no longer a member of the Society.
