PRELIMINARY PROCEEDINGS.

A^T the annual meeting of the PILGRIM SOCIETY, held at Pilgrim Hall, in Plymonth, at three o'clock, P.M., on Monday, May 30, 1870, it was voted that the Vice-President, together with ISAAC N. STODDARD, Esq., WILLIAM H. WHITMAN, Esq., and Dr. TIMOTINY GORDON, be a Committee to consider the expediency of celebrating the Two Hundred and Fiftieth Auniversary of the Landing of the Pilgrims, occurring on the 21st of December following, and report at an adjourned meeting.¹

At the adjourned meeting held at the same place on the 14th of June, at three o'clock, P.M., a report of the Committee recommending the Celebration was adopted, and a vote was passed requesting the Trustees to make the necessary arrangements.

At a meeting of the Trustees held at the Plymouth National Bank on the evening of July 5th, at eight o'clock, it was unanimously voted, on motion of RICHAED WARREN, Esq., that a Committee — consisting of the President, Vice-President, and Messrs. GORDON, WARREN, and AMES — wait upon Hon. ROBERT C. WINTHROP, of Boston, and invite him to deliver an Oration before the Society on the 21st of December.²
