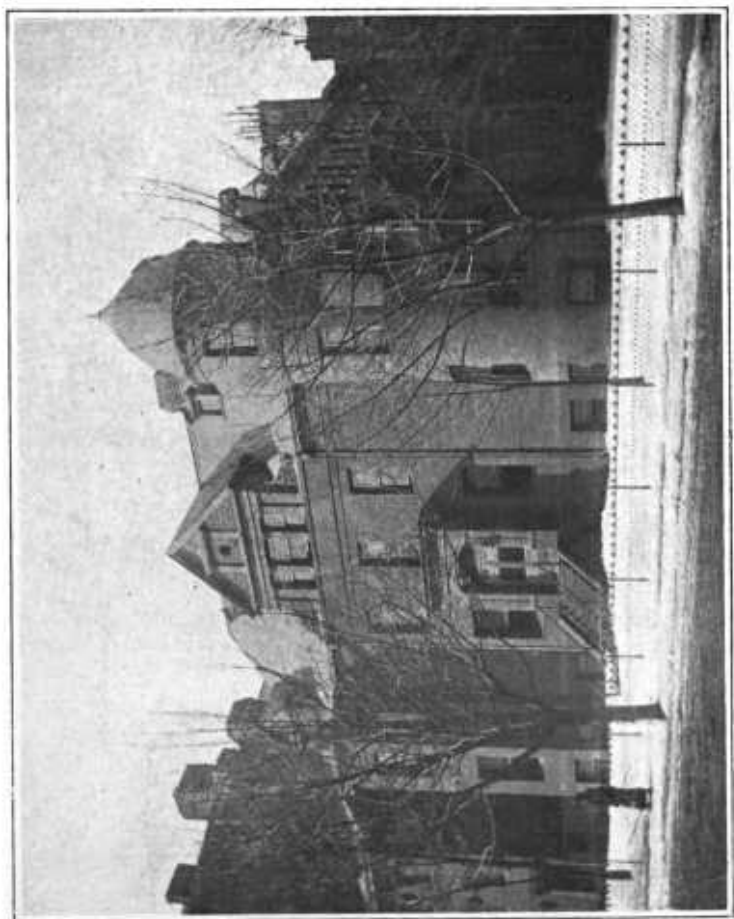

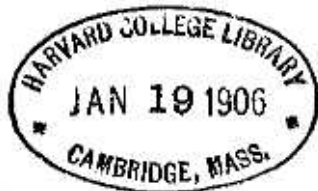

## **Certificate of Incorporation**

The undersigned persons more than three in number, of full age, all citizens of the United States and a majority of whom are citizens of the District of Columbia, desiring to associate themselves for certain purposes enumerated in section five hundred and ninety-nine of "An act to establish a code of law for the District of Columbia," approved March three, nineteen hundred and one, do now here make, sign and acknowledge this certificate of incorporation.

FIRST. The name or title by which this corporation shall be known in law is "THE UNIVERSITY CLUB, OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA."

SECOND. The term for which this corporation is organized is perpetual.

THIRD. The particular business and objects of this corporation are educational, literary, musical, scientific, for the promotion of the arts and for mutual improvement.

FOURTH. The number of trustees, directors, or managers of this corporation for the first year of its existence shall be twelve.

FIFTH. The said corporation shall have the power for themselves and their successors to have and use a common seal, and may alter and change the same at pleasure, and may make by-laws and elect officers and agents, and may take, receive, hold, and convey real and personal estate necessary for the purposes of the

corporation, and may take, receive, hold, and convey other real and personal property, the clear annual income from which shall not exceed in value twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).
