THE Library and Manuscripts of the late Professor Chandler having come under his will into the possession of Mrs. Evans, wife of the Rev. Evan Evans, D.D., Master of Pembroke College, Oxford, were presented by her to the College, with the approval of Professor Chandler's only sister, in memory of his profound learning and long connexion with the College. The Manuscripts, in accordance with his expressed desire, are not to be published.

The conditions of the gift are specified in the accompanying Extract :

Extract from the Deed of Gift executed by Mrs. Mary Sophia Evans, and dated October 17, 1889, conveying to the Master, Fellows, and Scholars of Pembroke College, Oxford, the Aristotelian and Philosophical Portions of the late Professor Chandler's Library.—

“To have and to hold the same for ever as a Memorial of the said Henry William Chandler Provided always that the said Books shall be kept together as a separate collection within the Library of Pembroke College aforesaid and shall be known as the Chandler Library and that such of the said books as owing either to their rarity or fine condition are of exceptional value shall be placed under lock and key and that the number of such keys shall be limited according to the discretion of the Master and Fellows of Pembroke College aforesaid and that none of the books forming part of the said Collection of whatsoever kind whether kept under lock and key or otherwise shall be lent outside the walls of the said College and that those books which are kept under lock and key as aforesaid shall not be taken out of the Library without the sanction of the Master and Fellows of Pembroke College aforesaid and that access to the said Collection shall be as far

as possible granted by the Master and Fellows of Pembroke College aforesaid to any student duly qualified and properly introduced who may be desirous of consulting any book or books in the said Collection and that the said Collection shall be inspected once in every year by the Librarian of Pembroke College aforesaid and that a report in writing shall be presented by him to the Master and Fellows of Pembroke College aforesaid and a copy of the same shall be sent to the Curators of the Bodleian Library in the University of Oxford and that a Catalogue of the books contained in the said Collection shall be made and printed at the cost of the Master Fellows and Scholars of Pembroke College aforesaid and that the condition of the gift shall be set forth at the beginning or end of the said Catalogue and that copies of the said Catalogue shall be sent to the Library of the British Museum in London to the Bodleian Library in the University of Oxford to each of the Libraries of the Colleges in the said University to the University Library at Cambridge and to such of the principal foreign Libraries as the Master and Fellows of Pembroke College aforesaid shall select Provided also and it is hereby further agreed and declared that if at any time it shall appear that the Master Fellows and Scholars of Pembroke College aforesaid have been guilty of gross negligence with regard to the custody of the said books or with regard to the observance of the conditions hereinbefore agreed upon then the whole of the said books shall become and be the property of the Chancellor Masters and Scholars of the University of Oxford and shall be placed in the Bodleian Library of the said University and shall be kept together as a single collection within the said Library and no book forming part of the said Collection shall be lent in such manner that it shall be taken outside the walls of the said Library."
