## PERIODICALS

### GENERAL INDEXES

The indexing of general periodicals is now on a very different basis from what it was two years ago. Poole's index, (Guide, p. 7), and its annual supplement as published in the Annual library index (Guide, p. 7.5), here here discontinued (Guide, p. 7-8) have been discontinued and the indexing of books and periodicals so long carried on by the latter work is a avanuation of so long carried on by the latter work is now being continued by an expansion of the Readers' guide (Guide, p. 8, Suppl. 1909-10, p. 7) which, beginning with 1913 appears in two sections, the Readers' guide, and the Readers' guide supplement, described below. The Readers' guide now indexes 90 periodicals and the Readers' guide supplement indexes 54, making a inter 54, making a

inderes 90 periodicals and the Readers' guide supplement indexes 64, making a total of 144 as against the 148 formerly indexed by the Readers' guide and the American library index. There has, how-ever, been a redistribution of titles. Of the 116 periodicals indexed in the Annual Horary index for 1910, 52 are now in-dexed in the Readers' guide, 22 in the Readers' guide supplement, 15 in the An-nual magazine subject index, 3 in the Book review digest, and 2 in the Indus-trial aris index, while 31 have been dropped altogether and their places taken by other titles which seem to promise greater usefulness.
