PREFACE.

IN offering this little work to English Physicians, it is not with the view of giving a complete history of the maladies or affections treated at Aix, which, indeed, would be a task difficult of execution, as it would expose the writer to frequent repetitions, and needlessly fatigue the readers. It would be necessary, in fact, to take up each malady separately, and indicate the treatment to be employed in every special case.

I have, above all, endeavoured to show, in as succinct a manner as possible, the physiological action of the waters of Aix, and the complete system of administering them.
