CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION OF
THE AUTHORS CLUB

Know all Men by these Presents, that we, Edmund C. Stedman, Charles de Kay, Brander Matthews, H. H. Boyesen, and George Parsons Lathrop, who are all of full age, citizens of the United States and of the State of New York, desiring to form ourselves into a Society or Club, pursuant to the provisions of

an Act of the Legislature of the State of New York, passed May 12, 1875, entitled: "An Act for the Incorporation of Societies or Clubs for certain lawful purposes," and of the several acts amending the same, do hereby certify:

First. The name or title by which such Society or Club shall be known in law is THE AUTHORS CLUB.

Second. The particular business and object of such Society or Club shall be literary and library purposes, and the promotion of social intercourse among authors.

Third. The number of Trustees, Directors, or Managers, to manage the same, shall be nine; and the names of such Trustees for the first year of its existence shall be Noah Brooks, George Cary Eggleston, W. Hamilton Gibson, Ripley Hitchcock, Bronson Howard, Thomas W. Knox, James Herbert Morse, Edmund Munroe Smith, and A. B. Starey.

Fourth. The principal office of such Society or Club shall be located in the City and County of New York.

In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our hands, this 10th day of February, 1887.
