EXPLANATORY PREFACE.

THE first part of this Catalogue gives a list of the Books in the Library of the Friends' Institute arranged alphabetically, generally under the Authors' names, and in the case of Biographies they are also entered under the name of the person whose life is written.

The second part is an index to the first with the books grouped into subjects; it gives short titles, and in some cases merely names of Authors, but these always connect with the fuller titles in the first part.

A Member desiring works on a particular subject should consult the Contents, in which will be found a full list of the main groups, together with their sub-divisions: from these he will select such as are likely to embrace the subject upon which he desires information. At the head of many of the groups will be found a paragraph containing a list of the books, which, although not especially pertaining to that group, yet contain information upon it; this paragraph also includes such books as pertain to the main group rather than to any of its sub-divisions: *e.g.*, SCIENCE GENERAL, Darwin.

The valuable collection of the publications of the *Parker Society* are arranged together alphabetically under HISTORY, CHURCH: the publications of the *Cobden Club* under SCIENCE MENTAL & MORAL, POLITICAL ECONOMY: *English Men of Letters* under BIOGRAPHY GENERAL: and the *Writings of the Fathers* under CHRISTIAN TEACHING.

The Pictures may be classified under two main heads, *viz.*, GALLERY, &c., and CABINET.

The former contains framed portraits of deceased Friends who have been prominent in the Society, or who were eminent in Science, Literature, Art, Manufacture, Philanthropy, Religion, or Social Reform. In it will also be found the representations of a few Meeting Houses and Schools, and (under the head "Miscellaneous") of various places and subjects closely connected with the Society's history.

The collection in the CABINET comprises:—

1st. Albums in which are many hundred *carte de visite* portraits of deceased Friends.

2nd. Portfolio and Cases containing Portraits of deceased Friends, and a variety of other pictures of interest to Friends generally.
