READING DEPARTMENT.

(A Reading Room for Ladies on the First Floor.)

1. The Reading Department of the Library shall be open daily: on Week-days from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., and from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m.; on Sundays from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m.

2. Every person desirous to read shall write his or her name, address, and occupation, in a Book provided for the purpose.

3. Before receiving a Book the Applicant shall fill up the following form:—

I REQUEST TO READ.

Signature of Applicant

4. SILENCE is requested in the Reading Rooms. It is expected that care be taken of the Books, and that the Volume read be returned to the Librarians when the reader leaves the Library.

5. SMOKING is strictly prohibited.

LENDING DEPARTMENT.

1. The Lending Department of the Library shall be open on Week-days from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., and from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m.

2. A Ratepayer shall be entitled to borrow a book from the Library, after having first obtained the Signature and Address of another Ratepayer, satisfactory to the Librarians, to the following form of Voucher. And on payment of 6d. per month (to be made in advance), or 1d. each on all vols. kept for the time specified on their respective covers.

3. A person, not a Ratepayer, shall be entitled to borrow a Book from the Library, after having first obtained the

Signature and Addresses of two Ratepayers satisfactory to the Librarians, to the following form of Voucher. And on payment of 6d. per month (to be made in advance), or 1d. each on all vols. kept for the time specified on their respective covers.

FORM OF VOUCHER.

To the LIBRARIANS of the FREE PUBLIC LIBRARY, 106, High Street, Notting Hill.

We the undersigned Ratepayers, hereby declare that we believe _____ to be a person to whom a Book may be safely entrusted for perusal, and we hereby undertake to replace any Book belonging to the Free Public Library, 106, High Street, Notting Hill, which shall be lost or injured by the said

3. The above form of Voucher, properly filled up, must be delivered to the Librarians at least two days before the first issue of a book shall be made to the person recommended, and all books borrowed must be returned to the Library within the time specified on the respective covers thereof, under the penalties thereon stated.

4. A Book may be borrowed on payment of a deposit of 2s. 6d., for a small volume (12mo.), or 5s. for a larger one (8vo.), the deposit to be returned to the borrower when the book is brought back. And also on payment of 6d. per month (to be made in advance), or 1d. each on all vols. kept for the time specified on their respective covers.

5. A person, not a Ratepayer, shall be exempt from payment, on making written application to the Librarians, stating on what grounds he or she so claims to be exempt; and if such application be satisfactory to the Librarians.

6. A period of three days must elapse between the issue of each vol. to the same reader.
