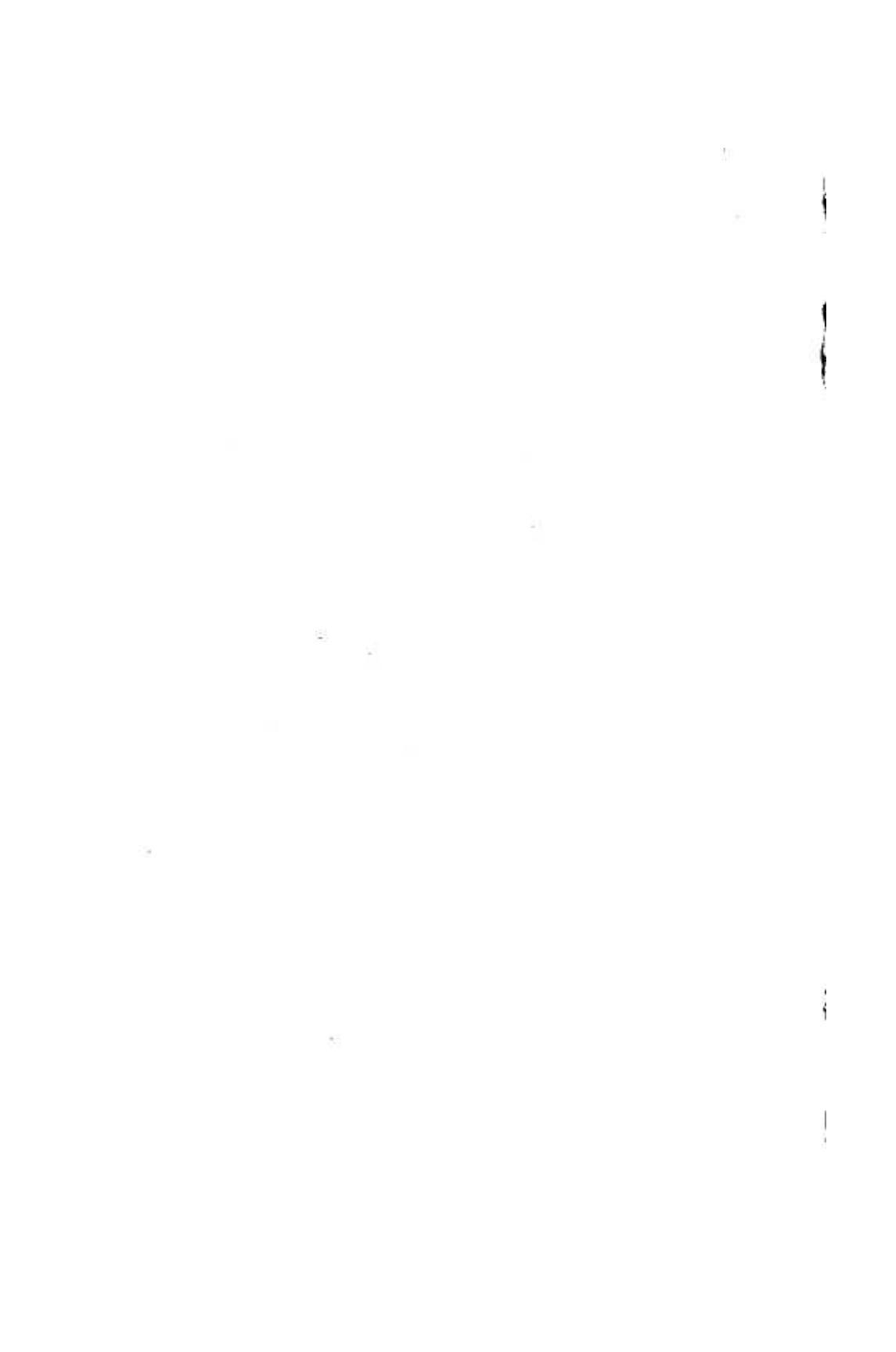
THESE Ten Lectures continue the Commentary on the Passion and Resurrection of Christ, contained in my volumes
