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EXTRACT FROM THE RECORDS OF THE COLONY OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY IN NEW ENGLAND.

At the Generall Court houlden at Boston, September 8th, @ 1636.

ORDERED, that the plantation to bee setled above the falls of Charles Ryver, shall have three yeares imunity fropublike charges, as Concord had, to bee accounted from the first of May next, & the name of the said plantation is to bee Deddam to enion all that land on the southerly & easterly side of Charles Ryver not formerly graunted to any towne, or pticuler psons, & also to have five miles square on the other side of the ryver.
