This volume, like the others of the series to which it belongs, has been compiled for the benefit of students and debaters, and for libraries wishing to supply good material in convenient form on the subject of government ownership. The present status of government regulation and government ownership of railroads in the United States and other countries, is briefly outlined in the Introduction and the General Discussion, while the Affirmative and Negative Discussions contain reprints of valuable material covering the arguments for and against the adoption of government ownership by the United States.
