PREFACE.

The Classification of the books is indicated by the capital letters in combination with the small letters. These signs are arbitrary, and are used for convenience in arranging books by subjects on the shelves and in the Finding List.

The synopsis of classification gives the main classes in connection with the sub-classes and the page on which each sub-class commences.

The books are arranged alphabetically by authors in each of the sub-classes excepting individual biography, which is arranged alphabetically according to the subjects of the biography.

The author index gives the names of the authors, editors or translators, and the pages on which their works will be found, except in works of fiction and individual biography.

In calling for a book, give author, title, class and number. Slips for that purpose will be found in the Reading Room.

Books that are at any one time needed by several patrons for the purpose of study may be temporarily transferred from the circulating to the reference library.

The name of the donor of each book will be found on the label attached to the cover. For most of the books thus far contributed, the public are indebted to the founders of the Library, Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Tainter.
