Phoebe Doolittle dau. of Rev. Phileson was b. May 25, 1759. She m. Nov. 13, 1788, Orange Dean b. Sept. 17, 1767 in Berkshire Co., Mass. Later they rem. to Black Rock, a suburb of Buffalo, kept a hotel and ran a ferry till these were destroyed when British burned the town in War of 1812; then lived with s. Orange at Caledonia, N. Y., where both d. and are buried. She d. Oct. 27, 1848—s. d. Mar. 28, 1842.
