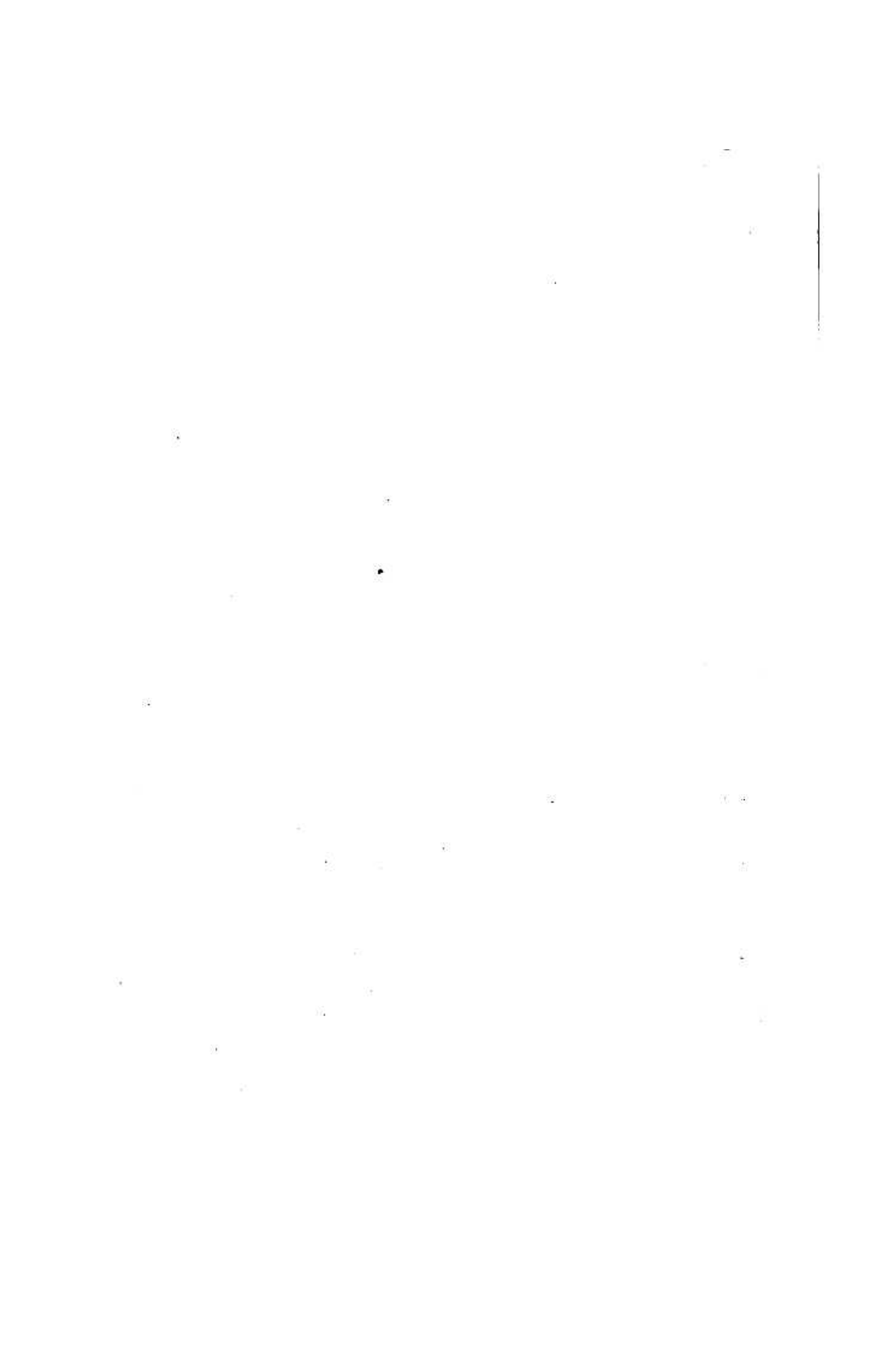
PREFACE.
