

PREFACE.

THE present Edition of the "Selection of Prayers,
Psalms, and Hymns" is, like its predecessor, of a provisional character. It is, however, considerably larger, and
will, it is hoped, be found more adequate for the needs of
worshippers at the Services of the Jewish Religious Union.
For a number of metrical versions or paraphrases of
Psalms, the Committee are indebted to Mrs. Henry Lucas,
