To the inhabitants of the Town of Amherst in the County of Hillsborough in said state, qualified to vote in Town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Wilkins School on Tuesday, the 2nd day of March, next at 7 of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

Article 1.

To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

Article 2.

To see if the Town will vote to make the following changes in the Zoning Map and the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of Amherst:

VOTE NO. 1

Town Center Commercial District

To see if the Town will vote to amend the Zoning Ordinance and Zoning Map as follows:

- A. To amend the Zoning Map of the Town of Amherst as follows:
The area designated on property map No. 6 as Lots 57-1 and 57-2 on Limbo Lane be amended so that they constitute a "Town Center Commercial District".
- B. To amend Article IV of the Zoning Ordinance by adding a new Section 4-11 Town Center Commercial District as follows:
 - A. General Purpose
To provide a centrally located area to serve limited
