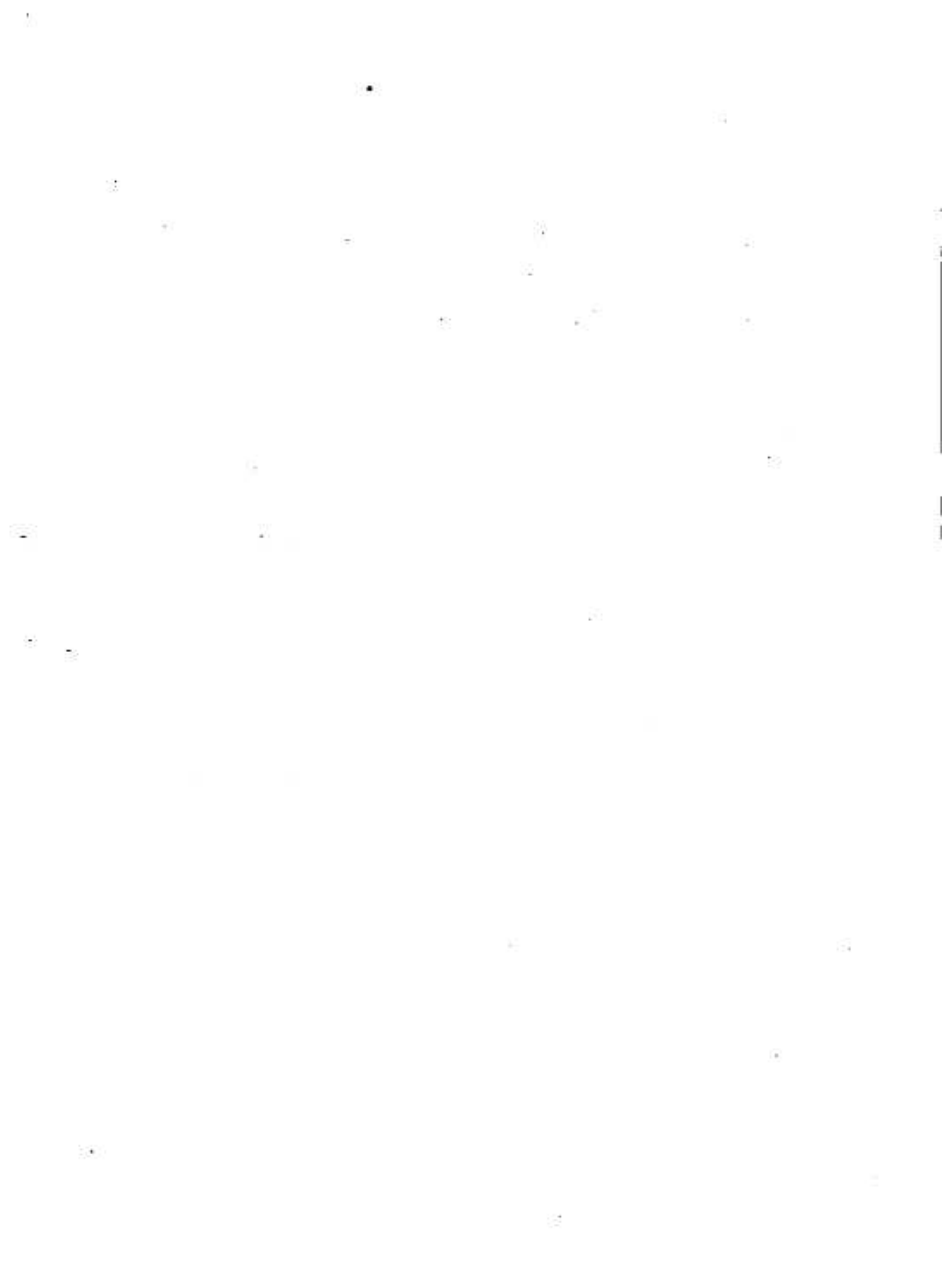
## PREFACE.
