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## PREFACE

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**T**HIS pamphlet will prove an invaluable aid to teachers of first year Latin, particularly in schools where the "Easy Latin Method" is used as a text-book.

The beginning Latin books do not, I think, classify the words sufficiently. I have found that first year Latin students can master twenty-five per cent more words, if the vocabulary be classified. Several of my fellow teachers have found the same to be true, and it is at their suggestion that this pamphlet is issued.

The proper names should be made, so far as possible, the basis of historical instruction so as to co-ordinate from the start in the mind of the pupil the two subjects—Latin and Ancient History.
