

#### THE LIBRARY OF THE DUTCH CHURCH, AUSTIN FRIARS.

Þ.

KING EDWARD the Sixth granted by Letters Patent, dated the 24th of July, 1550, "all the Church of the Augustine Friars, except the Quire," to John à Lasco and a congregation of Flemings and other Strangers, who had fied to this country for the sake of religion.

The Library was founded by Marie Dubois in the year 1650, some of the works having been collected before that period. Great additions were subsequently made; the Ministers of the Church, the Dutch East India Company, the Dutch Ambassadors, and the wealthy Members of the Congregation, being the principal contributors.

The Library was situated at the west end of the Church, over the screen, on either side of the organ.

In the year 1862 the Consistory of the Church, through their Treasurer Mr. Gerard Wynen, offered to place the whole of their Books, Manuscripts, Letters, &c., in the Guildhall Library, in order that the same
